AUDI TP52 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

NOTICE OF RACE

PORTO CERVO, 2nd - 8th OCTOBER 2011





1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The 2011 Audi TP52 World Championship is organised by the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda (YCCS) in conjunction with World Sailing Management (WSM) with the support of the TP52 Class Association.

2. VENUE AND DATES

The event will be held in the waters of Porto Cervo between the 2nd and the 8th October 2011. The regatta headquarters will be located at the YCCS.

3. RULES

3.1 The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

- a) The rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2009 - 2012);
- b) The ISAF Offshore Special Regulations governing Offshore Racing Category 3 including liferafts. (This amends class rule C.5.1. Reason is local regulations). For this event liferafts may be carried below decks (amends class rule C.5.4) if below 40kg. Liferafts shall be packed in a rigid container or canister. (Red parachute flares are not required - amends OSR 4.23, jackstays are not required - amends OSR 4.04). According with OSR 3.28.3.b) a minimum of 25 liters of fuel is required while racing;
- c) 2011 TP52 Rule, Bylaws and Interpretations;
- d) No National Authorities prescriptions will apply except Part 6 of prescriptions of the FIV (Italian Sailing Federation), which will apply solely to Italian competitors. A copy of prescription can be found in Appendix A.

3.2 In the event of discrepancy between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence. This changes rule 63.7.

3.3 The official language for the event will be English.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 The regatta is open to all TP52 boats holding a current and valid TP52 Certificate and owned by regular good standing members of the Class, or boats holding a One Event – TP52 Certificate and that comply with the conditions of 2011 TP52 Rule B.1. See TP52 Rule and Bylaws at: www.transpac52.org.

4.2 The decision with regard to Nationality and registration remains with the boat's owner.

5. ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

5.1 Entries shall be made on the Official Entry Form (Annex 1) and shall be received duly completed by the Organising Authority by 1st September 2011, accompanied by a copy of a valid TP52 Certificate and by a non-refundable Entry Fee of 1.100 Euro.

5.2 Entries received after 1st September 2011 will require the payment of an additional fee of 600 Euro (Total Entry Fee for late entries will be 1.700 Euro).

5.3 The entry fee shall be paid by bank transfer. A copy of the transfer confirmation is to accompany the entry form. Please send the transfer payments to:

5.4 The TP52 Class Members that wish to compete for the TP52 Worlds Owner Driver Trophy are to lodge the TP52 Class Helmsman Application / Owner Driver Registration Forms (available from the Class Manager or on the website) with the Class manager by the 1st October 2011. Late applications may be accepted at the discretion of the Class Manager.

5.5 No TP52 Class Member shall compete for the TP52 Worlds Owner Driver Trophy unless his eligibility has been approved by the TP52 Eligibility Committee; see the TP52 Bylaws for the requirements.



5.6 To qualify as a competitor the following shall be lodged with the Race Office prior to the close of registration on 03rd October 2011:

- a) Current and valid TP52 Certificate;
- b) Sails Declaration Form;
- c) Crew Declaration Form, submitted by 10.00 hours on 03rd October;
- d) Guest Declaration Form, submitted by 10.00 hours on 03rd October;
- e) Compliance Declaration by Owners, Tacticians and Boat Captains;
- f) TP52 Class Helmsman Application / Owner Driver Forms, if applicable;
- g) Valid insurance certificate for Third Party Indemnity with a sum insured over 1.5 million Euros (or its equivalent in another currency);
- h) Display sponsors flags, stickers, and any other items as stated by the NOR / Sailing Instructions.

6. MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

6.1 Measurement will take place from 2nd to 3rd October 2011 in Porto Cervo.

6.2 A boat shall provide a minimum of 2 people to help with measurement checking.

6.3 Boat Measurement: each boat shall be presented for measurement in its last measurement flotation trim condition.

6.4 Sail Measurement: sail measurement will take place from 10.00 to 18.00 hours on 2nd and 3rd October 2011. Location will be posted on the Official Notice Board of the event.

6.5 Sail Limit:

- Boats that have not participated in the 2011 Audi MedCup Circuit may measure a maximum of 20 sails of which a maximum of 5 sails may not have been measured for previous TP52 or IRC events;
- Boats that have participated in the 2011 Audi MedCup Circuit may measure a maximum of 20 sails, of which no more than 3 may be sails that do not have a 2011 MedCup sticker or stamp;
- Heavy Weather Jib, trysail and stormsail are not counted for the sail limit;
- Sails that do not meet initial measurement criteria may only be re-measured twice;
- Only stamped sails or marked by the Class Measurer shall be eligible to be used in the TP52 Audi World Championship 2011;
- 2011 Worlds stamped or marked sails may be modified provided no more than the allowable percentage of the declared area of the sail is replaced. Approval shall be sought from the class measurer prior to carrying out any sail repair or modification:

Allowable % repair / modification:	Mainsail 20%
	Spinnaker 30%
	Headsail 20%

- Repairs above the allowable percentage shall not be executed without permission of the Jury following a request made in writing indicating reason and describing the repair. Repairs or alterations may be subject to control;

- In case of major repairs over the allowable percentage the Jury may consider to allow replacing the sail by a similar sail from that boat's sail wardrobe, provided the sail has an Audi MedCup sticker or stamp, or in case the boat has not participated in the 2011 Audi MedCup, that the sail is a used sail certified for previous TP52 or IRC events. In that case the class measurer shall certify the sail with the event's stamp or mark before it may be used.

6.6 Crew and Guest:

- a) A boat shall race with the entire crew as declared in the registration form for the entire regatta. Any changes to the Crew shall have valid reason and shall be submitted in good faith to the Jury for their approval. Only substitutions approved by the IJ will be accepted;
- b) The maximum crew weight while racing at the event will be 1050kg (Option C.2.2.a 2011 TP52 Rule);
- c) Guests on board: in addition to the maximum crew weight limit boats shall have a guest on board every day of racing who shall:
 - 1) Not contribute to the racing of the yacht other than by the positioning of their weight. Unless otherwise prescribed by the Sailing Instructions, a person with acknowledged tactical or technical skills (yacht designers, sail designers or sailing coaches would be



- specific though non exhaustive examples) shall be considered to be contributing to the racing of the yacht;
- 2) Be positioned after of the mainsail traveller and with their legs and torso inboard of a vertical line above the sheer line;
 - 3) Be provided by YCCS or WSM for one of the official racing days unless a team indicates on the entry form that the guest position will be taken for the duration of the event by the owner/class member or one of his relatives. YCCS or WSM may also provide Guests for the rest of the racing days if boats cannot fill this position;
 - 4) Wear clothing of a color which distinguishes the Guest from other crew members;
 - 5) The guest shall be on board for a minimum of one race day. The guest name(s), weight(s) and designated race day(s) shall be communicated by the Guest Declaration Form. The non YCCS or WSM guests are invited by the boat and under full responsibility of the boat;
 - 6) The Race Organizer may refuse any guest. Boats are denied the possibility to contest this decision.

The jury may impose a 5-point penalty in the event scoring every time a boat fails to comply with rule 6.6. This penalty can be awarded without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1.

6.7 Boats may be inspected by the TP52 Class Officials at any time during the regatta.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1 Schedule:

October 2nd and 3rd (Sunday and Monday) Measurement, Inspections and Registration.
Race Office opens 10.00 hrs each day.

October 3 rd 18.00 hrs.	Skippers Briefing
October 4 th (Tuesday)	W-L Race(s)
October 5 th (Wednesday)	W-L Race(s)
October 6 th (Thursday)	Coastal Race
October 7 th (Friday)	W-L Race(s)
October 8 th (Saturday)	W-L Race(s) Prizegiving.

7.2 A maximum of 9 races shall be sailed. No more than 3 races per day will be sailed. The event will be valid if 3 or more races are sailed.

7.3 The Organising Authority and/or the Race Committee reserve the right to modify the programme for any reason.

8. EVENT ADVERTISING DURING REGATTA

8.1 The event is designated Category C under the ISAF Advertising code, Regulation 20. Boats that intend to display advertising in accordance with category C must so indicate on their Entry Form.

8.2 Competitors are requested to respect the brand exclusivity of the Official Sponsor(s) of this event. Their participation enhances the event for all competitors.

Boats that intend to display advertising in accordance with Category C during the regatta shall state in the entry form the nature of such advertising. If a boat that has already entered acquires advertising or changes her advertising, she shall inform the Organizing Authority of the changes made.

Boats are responsible to inform advertisers and sponsors that no activities advertising any brand advertised on competing boats (except for sponsors involved in the TP52 Audi World Championship 2011) will be permitted ashore within the YCCS or Porto Cervo Marina areas without the consent in writing of the Organizing Authority obtained before the start of the Regatta.

8.3 All boats shall apply the event bow sticker and bow number to both sides of the bow for the entire duration of the Regatta, immediately after registration and at least until one hour after the finish of the last race. Boats participating at the last 2011 Audi MedCup Circuit event shall keep the bow number given.

All boats might be requested to hoist a sponsor's flag and a battle flag with the logo of the event. The sponsor's flag might be requested to be flown on the backstay of the boat from



12.00 hours on the 4th October to one hour after the finish of the last race of the Series. The battle flag might be requested to be flown while moored for the entire duration of the Regatta commencing immediately following registration until one hour after the finish of the last race.

The Organising Authority in agreement with the TP52 Class may request the boats to display also advertising stickers on both sides of the boom and cockpit sides. Details of this advertising, if applicable, will be communicated to the boats not later than 1st October 2011.

8.4 The Organizing Authority may also require the installation, at no cost to competitors, of on board video cameras for the official television production and/or the installation of satellite monitoring equipment for the boat tracking system. The aforesaid equipment has been designed not to interfere with the instrumentation and the various communication equipment on board. In such cases, the Organizing Committee will provide the installation.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Regatta Office on the 2nd October.

10. RACING AREA AND COURSES

The racing area will be the waters of Porto Cervo and La Maddalena Archipelago.

11. RACING FORMAT

9 races are scheduled. It is intention of the RC to race Windward/Leeward Races and 1 Coastal race (approximately 30 - 50 miles). A shorter or longer distance for the Coastal Races shall not be ground for protest.

12. SCORING

12.1 The Low Point Scoring System as described in RRS Appendix A shall apply.

12.2 The weighting of races is as follows:

Windward/Leeward Races: results will be multiplied by coefficient 1.0

Coastal Race: results will be multiplied by coefficient 1.25

13. JURY

13.1 An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix N. All decisions will be final as per RRS 70.5.

13.2 Umpiring: it is the intention of the Organising Authority to have the racing umpired. ISAF Addendum Q will be modified to the effect that the Jury may take decisions after racing if the incident afloat was unseen.

14. ACCOMMODATION, MOORINGS, PARKING, STORAGE

The entry fee covers the cost for all mooring expenses for one TP52 boat and one tender per team between the 2nd and the 9th of October (both included). Parking for one van is included. Containers shall be stored at competitors cost either at Marina de Porto Cervo Yard or the designated parking.

The Organising Authority will facilitate “within reason” the use of the events press facilities for one dedicated media representative of each team.

15. HAUL - OUT, DIVING RESTRICTIONS

Boats may not be hauled out after the 3rd October until the finish of the final race without prior written permission of the Jury. Cleaning in the water is permitted for divers registered with the Organising Authority.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephony.

17. PRIZES

17.1 Overall series awards based on the cumulative scores for the regatta will be awarded to first through third place boats after the final race of the championship series.



17.2 The TP52 Owner Driver Trophy, will be awarded to the top scoring Owner/TP52 Class Member who drives his boat in every starting sequence, the W/L- buoy races from the starting sequence to the finish and the first 30 minutes of the Coastal Race. The Owner shall not be relieved at the helm by a Group 1 driver at any time during the specified time period. Owners shall indicate on their entry form if they wish to compete for this trophy.

17.3 The TP52 World Championship Trophy and keeper award will be presented to the first place boat in the championship regatta.

Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, relieving of any responsibility the Events Sponsors, the Organising Authority, the TP52 Class and all persons involved in the organisation under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

Competitors are to be acquainted with ISAF RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".

In any case, competitors agree that the Event Organizers, the TP52 Class, the sponsors and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember will be required to sign a declaration accepting this disclaimer of liability.

20. MEDIA RIGHTS

Teams and Participants grant Event Organizers the unrestricted right and permission to use the names and the image for any text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event to be published or broadcasted in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to press and TV advertisements or internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information; in these respect Teams and Participants names and biographical material of themselves may also be used or reproduced in any way known.

Participants undertake not to do or allow any act of reproduction, public communication or distribution of images concerning the 2011 Audi TP52 World Championship without previous authorization from the Organizing Authority.

21. AMENDMENTS TO THIS NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend this Notice of Race. Any amendments of this Notice of Race made prior to the 1st October will be posted on the event's website and emailed to those Owners whose entries have been accepted. Amendments will be posted on the Official Notice Board and copies will be available at the Race Office.
