**NOTICE OF RACE
PORTO CERVO, 29th JUNE - 2nd JULY**







1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda (YCCS) in conjunction with the Farr 40 European Fleet Association.

2. HEADQUARTERS

3. RULES

- 3.1 This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Farr 40 Class Rules.
- 3.2 Yachts shall comply with the current ISAF Offshore Special Regulations, Category 4 (except neither 5.01.2 nor 4.26.4(g) shall apply for this event) and Appendix 3 of the Farr 40 Class Rules. In the event of conflict, designer and manufacturers original standards shall prevail.
- 3.3 Remove the second sentence of RRS 30.2 and replace with the following: "If a boat breaks this rule and is identified, she shall receive, without a hearing, a 10% scoring penalty calculated as stated in rule 44.3 (c)".
- 3.4 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that, except for infringements of Part 2 that occur within three boat lengths of a rounding mark or finishing mark, only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 3.5 The maximum amount of drinkable liquid aboard each yacht shall not exceed six litres per person per day. This liquid is included in the restrictions for movable ballast in RRS 51.
- 3.6 In RRS 61.1 (a), after the second sentence, add the words: "The red flag shall have the minimum dimensions of 45 cm x 45 cm and shall be displayed vertically from the backstay." This changes RRS 61.1 (a).
- 3.7 Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6.
- 3.8 Where there is conflict with the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail except that neither shall change nor alter any Class Rules except 31.1. This alters 63.7.
- 3.9 Italian competitors shall be in compliance with the Italian Sailing Federation Rules requiring FIV cards. Other Italian Federation prescriptions do not apply.
- 3.10 The event is the 2nd series of the Farr 40 European Circuit 2011.

4 ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all Farr 40 Class yachts as defined by the Class Rules. Owners, Charterers and Substitute helmsmen shall be current members of the Farr 40 Class Association and shall be approved by the Farr 40 Class Eligibility Review Committee.

5 ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 5.1 Entry Forms are available at: www.yccs.com
- 5.2 The Entry Form, a copy of a valid 2011 One Design Certificate and the Entry Fee of € 800 shall be submitted to the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda no later than 10th May 2011. Late entries may be accepted, however an additional fee of € 500 will be charged for entries received after 10th May 2011.



- 5.3 Crew lists and ISAF Sailor User IDs for all crew, along with designation of relief or substitute helmsmen shall be submitted to Farr 40 Association no later than 30th May 2011.
- 5.4 Registration shall be completed with the OA as described below. Sail declarations may be made on site during registration. No later than 1600 hours on 28th June 2011, all entries shall have completed the following:
- (a) Registration with OA, including fees;
 - (b) Entry Form and 2011 One Design Certificate on file with the OA;
 - (c) Owner, Charterer, and Substitute Helmsman Class Membership Dues for 2011 paid and on file with Farr 40 Class Association;
 - (d) European Fleet Membership dues for 2011, paid and on file with European Fleet Secretariat;
 - (e) Skipper and crew weighing, and liability waivers signed and on file with the OA;
 - (f) Sail Declaration form on file with the OA;
 - (g) Measurement forms on file with the OA;
 - (h) Crew classification declared and verified on the Sail/Crew Declaration form, and on file with the OA;
 - (i) Owner/Skipper shall be a member of their Member National Authority;
 - (j) All owners, tacticians and boat captains shall have signed and submitted to the OA Appendix 10 stating that their boat fully complies with Class Rules and that they will abide by said Class Rules while racing.

- 6.2 The Race Committee intends to conduct as many races as practicable on each scheduled day of racing, up to a maximum of 9 races for the Series.
- 6.3 After consultation with a non-competing Class Representative, the OA and/or PRO may modify the above programme according to prevailing weather conditions and/or other unforeseen circumstances.

7. MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

- 7.1 Crew will be weighed on the official scales at Race Headquarters.
- 7.2 Random yacht and equipment inspections may be conducted prior to, between races and after racing each day to check for compliance with Class Rules, the NOR and the current ISAF Offshore Special Regulations, Category 4.

8. EVENT ADVERTISING

- 8.1 Boats may display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code. Boats shall display Event Advertising in compliance with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code, and as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2 Boats will be required to display the following throughout the period starting one hour after the completion of registration and ending one hour after the finish of the last race of the regatta:
- Sponsor's pennant on the backstay
 - Sponsor's decal on each side of the bow
- 8.3 In addition boats will be required to display the event flag throughout the same period but only while moored.



- 8.4 The Organizing Authority will supply the pennant, decal and flag at registration.
- 8.5 The Organizing Authority may also require the installation, at no cost to competitors, of on board video cameras for the official television production and/or a tracking system.
- 8.6 Boats intending to display advertising during the regatta shall state in the entry form the nature of such advertising.
- 8.7 Boats are responsible to inform advertisers and sponsors that no activities advertising any brand will be permitted ashore within the Porto Cervo Marina Area without the consent in writing of the Organizing Authority obtained before the start of the Regatta.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and at www.yccs.com

10 COURSES AND RACING AREA

Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions. Races will be held on the waters off Porto Cervo and/or the Gulf or Arzachena. Sailing is forbidden by the Italian Law inside the harbour.

11 PENALTIES

11.1 RRS 30.2, 44.1 and 44.2 are changed as described in NOR 3.3 and 3.4.

11.2 The penalty, if any, for any infringement of the rules (including the Class Rules and ISAF Offshore Special Regulations, Category 4) other than RRS Part 2 is at the sole discretion of the Jury in consultation with the Class representative, and may be other than disqualification. This changes RRS 64.1.

12 SCORING

Each yacht's score shall be the sum of all her races (no discards). Ten (10) races are scheduled. Completion of four races constitutes a regatta. This Changes RRS A2.

13 INTERNATIONAL JURY

Decisions of the International Jury shall be final (RRS 70.5).

14 PRIZES

Trophies for first through fifth place overall will be awarded.

15 DOCKAGE

15.1 The Entry Fee includes moorings from 09.00 hrs on 28th June 2011 to 10.00 hrs on 3rd July 2011 provided that the completed Entry Form and Fee are received before 10th May 2011.

15.2 Payment for water and electricity will be responsibility of each boat and shall be paid directly to the Marina Office. Should a mooring be required for a longer period, entrants may extend the booking by contacting the Marina Office directly. Extended bookings will be chargeable at the current marina rates. Early booking is recommended. Telephone bookings must be confirmed by fax, email or post.

15.3 The OA will be responsible for the assignment of mooring positions for all entrants. All entrants will be notified on their arrival in Porto Cervo of their mooring position.



16 SUPPORT BOATS

- 16.1 Competitors' attention is drawn to the applicable Class Rules and Interpretations.
- 16.2 Support and Media boats shall register with the OA.

17 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Yachts may be hauled out during the regatta only with the prior written permission of the International Jury, and under such terms as they may decide. Normally, the Jury shall grant such permission only if necessary to repair damage. While hauled out, bottoms and foils shall not be sanded, polished, washed, or otherwise worked on except as permitted by the Jury in the area of repair. Hulls and appendages may be cleaned in the water.

18 MEDIA & IMAGE RIGHTS WAIVER

- 18.1 The Media Centre will be at Regatta Headquarters.
- 18.2 At no cost to the competitors, the OA may request the installation of onboard tracking and/or video cameras for the purposes of the official television production.
- 18.3 By entering this regatta, the owner (or charterer) and crew members on competing yachts grant at no cost the absolute right and permission to use their names, voices, images, likenesses, and biographical material, as well as representations of their yacht:
- (a) in any media (including television, print and internet), to the Organizing Authority, the Farr 40 Management Group, Stagg Yachts, the Farr 40 Executive Committee, the Farr 40 European Fleet Management Group and all affiliated companies, other sponsors;
- 18.4 Owners (charterers) and crew members shall acknowledge and accept the granting of media rights referred to in this paragraph 18 by signing the Entry Form and the Disclaimer and Acknowledgement of Rights Form provided by the OA.

19 DISCLAIMER

- 19.1 All those taking part in the race do so at their own risk and responsibility. The owner (charterer) and each crewmember:
- (a) acknowledges and accepts the risks (including the risk of harm to persons and property and the risks associated with the perils of the sea and the seaworthiness of any boat) associated with participation in this regatta and waives all rights against and releases the Organizing Authority, the Farr 40 Management Group, Stagg Yachts, the Farr 40 Executive Committee, the Farr 40 European Fleet Management Group and all their respective officers, employees, volunteers and members in respect of any loss of life or injury to persons, or loss of or damage to property, suffered in connection therewith;
 - (b) acknowledges that participation in this regatta by him or her is on the basis that participation is entirely at his or her risk and responsibility and that the Organizing Authority, the Farr 40 Management Group, Stagg Yachts, the Farr 40 Executive Committee, the Farr 40 European Fleet Management Group and all their respective officers, employees, volunteers and members are not responsible for any boat or its crew;
 - (c) acknowledges and agrees that this form is governed by the laws of Italy and that any liability for harm to persons that results from breach of an express or implied warranty that this regatta and all services relating thereto will be conducted or rendered with reasonable care and skill is excluded.
- 19.2 Specific attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4, which states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".
- 19.3 All competitors shall acknowledge this by signing the Disclaimer and Acknowledgment of Rights Form provided by the Organizing Authority.

20 INSURANCE

- 20.1 The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole inescapable responsibility of the owner/owners' representative. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide insurance for the yacht covering eventual damage to persons or property.



- 20.2 The boat is required to hold adequate insurance including third-party insurance of minimum cover of 1,000,000 Euro, and it is the owner or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event.
