USEFUL INFORMATION

<u>Currency</u> - Local currency is the US dollar

There are no cash points / ATMs in the North Sound. The easiest place to withdraw cash is the airport upon arrival, alternatively the nearest ATM is in Spanish Town, Virgin Gorda - a 20 minute taxi ride away,

<u>Arriving By AIR</u> - If you are travelling on to Virgin Gorda, Anegada, Peter Island, or Jost van Dyke, check with your hotel, resort, or villa to make sure that charter flights or ferry service will be available if you arrive after 4pm. Otherwise, plan to spend a night or two in Tortola before exploring the rest of "Nature's Little Secrets." Boat charters can be arranged via St. Thomas, Road Town or Beef Island. Click here for the complete ferry schedule.

<u>Arriving by SEA</u> - Customs and Immigration Offices: Tortola—Road Town and the West End, Virgin Gorda—Virgin Gorda Airport, St. Thomas Bay Terminal, and the Owen Harrigan Visitors Centre at Gun Creek, Jost Van Dyke—Great Harbour. As of January 31, 2008, U.S. Citizens travelling by sea may be required to present a valid passport or other documents as determined to enter or re-enter the United States. Visitors from other countries may also require a visa for entry.

Driving - A valid driving license is required by all those seeking to drive in the British Virgin Islands. Driving is on the left-hand side of the road throughout the islands. Minimum age for hiring a rental car is 25 years.

<u>Passport</u> - A valid passport is required to enter the British Virgin Islands with proof of a return or onward ticket. Visitors from some countries may require a visa - if in doubt please check with your nearest BVI Tourist Board.

<u>Voltage</u> - The electrical current is 110 volt, 60 cycles.

Weather - The average temperature is 29°C/84°F in summer and 27°C/80°F in winter. Average annual rainfall is approx 45 inches. Click here to view weather forecast

<u>**Time Zone</u>** - Atlantic Standard Time (AST): 4 hours behind GMT and I hour ahead of EST.</u>

<u>Credit Cards</u> - Visa and Mastercard are widely accepted in most hotels, shops and larger restaurants; American Express is accepted in some establishments. Smaller establishments do not accept credit cards.
